SUBJECT: **ATTORNEY VISITS – PROTECTIVE CUSTODY INMATES**

Recently, there has been an issue of attorneys having a lengthy wait while attempting to see their clients who are in protective custody. We have a construction project which will soon be under way and once it is complete, we plan to put phones into the locked attorney rooms to allow inmates of different classifications to be there at the same time.

In the interim, attorneys coming to see a protective custody inmate between 11 AM and 1 PM on Monday through Friday will be given priority access to the rooms. If there is an attorney here to see a protective custody inmate, s/he will bump any other attorney who is here to see a client. The purpose of this arrangement is to ensure that CPCS and other attorneys have access to their clients regardless of their classification status.

This protocol will be effective on May 4, 2015. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
